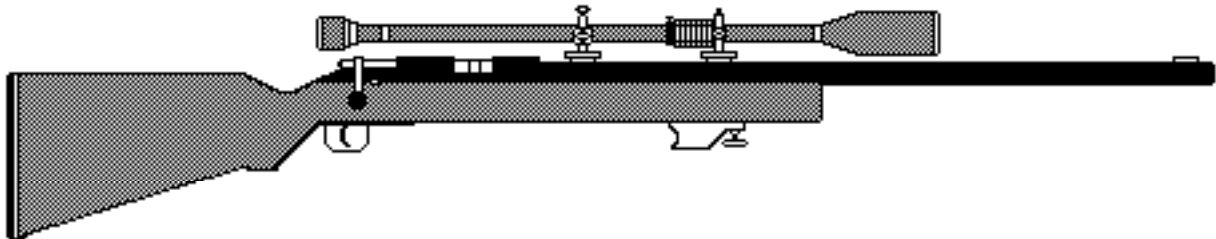

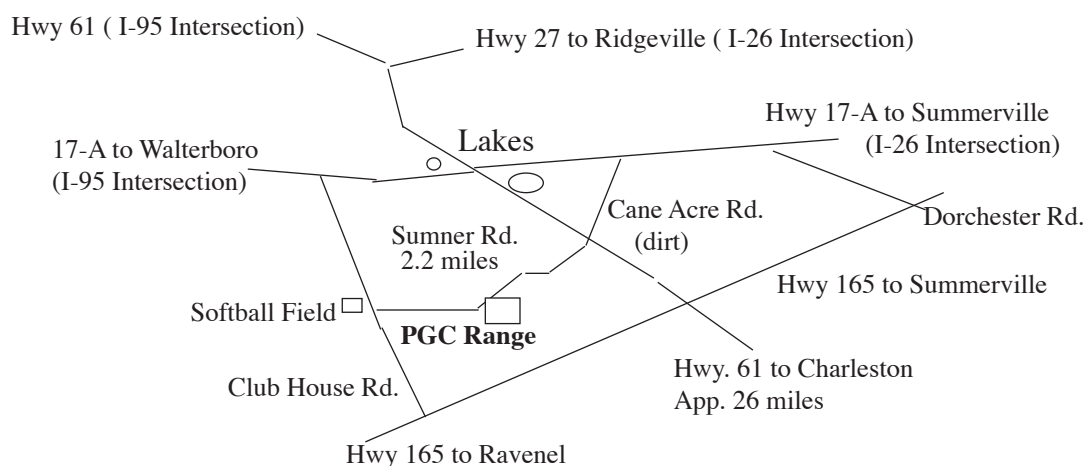

METRIC 1600 PRONE MATCH: 60 SHOTS AT 50 YARDS PLUS 60 SHOTS AT 100 YDS.
CONVENTIONAL 1600 PRONE MATCH: 60 SHOTS 50 YDS. PLUS 60 SHOTS AT 100 YDS.
REGIONAL 3200 MATCH: 320 SHOTS (fired as an iron 1600 plus an any-sight 1600).

- Rules Current NRA Smallbore Rules.
- Metric Target 50 yard A-51; 100 yard A-33 Prone Matches.
- Conv. Target.....50 yard A-23, A-26 or A27; 100 yard A-25 Prone Matches.
- Sights..... Check Match Dates for any sight or iron only status.
- EligibilityApproved Match; NRA membership is not required. (Registered it is required)
- RelaysRelays and firing points to be posted prior to start of matches.
- Firing Points..... 40 points per relay. Total of 2 relays per day on a covered concrete pad.
- Firearm.....Any Rifle as outlined in the current NRA Smallbore rules.
- EquipmentEye and Ear protection recommended and Empty Chamber Indicators are required.
- AmmunitionCompetitors to furnish their own as outlined in the current NRA Smallbore rules.
- Starting TimeRegistration from 8:00 am to 8:30 am. Firing begins at 9:00 am.
- ClassificationNRA classifications will be used.
- AwardsMatch winners and places, class, and category awards (if there are 5 or more competitors within class and category). Match Winner.
- EntriesIndividual: SR-1 Registration Card. Pre-registration appreciated.
- LocationRidgeville Range facilities located on Summer Rd.
- Fees.....Individuals: Adults.....\$20.00 Juniors.....10.00
