- Date:** June 10,11,12, &13, 2004
Please read the entire program; there has been changes.
- Eligibility:** Open to NRA members or Jr members of an affiliated club.
- Rules:** Current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules will govern. Competitors without a conventional prone classification card will fire in the master class. Any Rifle, Rule 3.2.
- Range:** Covered, 168" by 28" wide.
- Challenges:** \$1.00 for a competitor's own target, \$3.00 for another competitor's target. Rule 16.1.
- Fees:** Match fee \$134.50 + \$5.50 NRA fee + \$10.00 club registration. Total registration fee \$150
- Entries:** Advance entries are required. Fees will be returned if cancelled 2 weeks in advance of the match.

Official entries are made when check and entry card are received. All entries must be received by May 25. Confirmation cards will be mailed June 2. Firing points will be determined by a random drawing after all entries are received, assigning positions from the middle of the range outward. Competitors' firing points will be moved 8 ports every day. Sample, Point 1, then 9, 17, & 25. Relays will be reversed every day. No more than 32 entries of any one class will be accepted. Range capacity is 64 competitors.

- Awards:** Awards will be cash, NRA points or merchandise. 65% of match fees will be returned as awards; for example, \$5200 minimum for 60 shooters **plus donations of money & merchandise.** An open winner will be awarded in each match. When there are less than 5 shooters but a minimum of 3, the award will be pro-rated. Less than 3 may be combined with the next higher class. Classes will be subdivided into 2 categories, civilian and service, if there are sufficient entries, Rule 2.2. No categories for open awards. Scope class available for shooters 55 and over, any age for a shooter with a visual disability. One award per person per match.
Match results will be available at the awards ceremony immediately following the matches.
