



January 17th , 2012 Meeting Minutes

Location: The Citadel, Altman Center, Johnson Hagood Stadium Time: 19:00

Old Business

1. West Vaco – Progress Report Draft 35 page contract delivered to PGC Executive Board on 01-10-12. Board to meet again to discuss and fill in some blanks on 01-24-12.
2. Glock Special Drawing – All tickets sold. Drawing to be held at February PGC meeting
3. Nominations Open for 2012 Executive Board – Nominations for Executive Board are now open. Submit your nominations to club secretary.
4. New Classroom – New 24X28 mobile building to be delivered in mid-February. No issues with property taxes for 2011. No problem with delivery down access road. No problem with delivery through gate without modifications. Bathroom exemption letter received from Dorchester County.
5. Electrical upgrade update – Bob Clark is getting bids for the work.

6. Range signs posted on Summer Road – By SC law, this is a requirement that the County post signs. PGC cannot post signs without a permit to post in the State or County right-of-way. PGC will write Dorchester County a letter reminding them of their responsibility to post range signs.
7. Cold Range sign – New signs for Cold Range, Match ongoing, welcome to PGC, match registration, and class registration signs to be made up and available within the next two months.

New Business

8. Motion: to move PGC Monthly Meetings to Olde Village Community Center on Jenkins Ave, across the street from North Charleston High School Football Stadium. 44 in favor, 11 opposed, 2 not voting. We believe we're obligated under contract with the Citadel through February. Jeremy Gilbert is confirming this. The contracts with the City of North Charleston run from April through March each year, so we will commence two trial meetings at the Olde Village Community Center starting in March. After two meetings, the Club will have the opportunity to renew the Olde Village Community Center contract for the next year or look for another place.
