Treasurer's Report: Jeremy Gilbert listed the balances of the various PGC accounts.

Match & Program Reports:

Small Bore – Small match. Regionals in Atlanta. Match this Saturday, June 19th.

IDPA pistol – No match since last report. Next match June 19th, small 30 round count but very challenging.

No shooting for July or August.

RBA Small-bore Benchrest: 5 shooters, all local.

Highpower Rifle: 8-9 shooters. Great shooting.

IPSC/USPSA: 28 shooters. Jack Suber from Columbia won.

IBS Centerfire Benchrest: Doc Wooten won. 1 point dropped at 200.

Cowboy: No formal report, members present had a good time.

Long Range Rifle: 9 shooters. 4 bench rest.. 4 in F class

Steel Challenge: 44 guns.

Junior Pistol: Still looking for one more junior for steel challenge team.

Women on Target: May 16th. 12 women participated. Great time. Enjoyed all the disciplines that were set up.

IDPA Range Officers Course (July 17th @ 8am). Bobby Albert instructor. No charge for class.

IDPA Introduction to discipline. July 17th @ 10am. Carl Hoffman instructor. No charge for class.

Workday: 20 people. Had some people upset because they could not shoot and packed up and left. Next workday is July 31st.

Message from President: you can invite someone to the range 2 times only. If you go beyond two visits you are violating the bylaws. Anyone wishing to use the range past 2 visits is asked to join the club. You can hire an instructor to come in and teach a course but club members who are not instructors cannot charge friends and teach them at the range. (If you have any questions about all this, please contact Gary Wilson)

Old Business:

Bill Craver read letter sent to Mead Westvaco this week. It's a "Property Exchange Letter". This letter starts a running list of items to be addressed by Westvaco.

Foster Gillard is the attorney's chosen to represent PGC.

Concurrent use of both ranges is mandatory according to the range act to establish new range. We can't stop shooting any disciplines at the old range or new range in order to be protected by the range act. Must have both ranges running all the time. Logistics must be worked out. All details of this will be determined once the letter is accepted by Westvaco. There has been no \$\$ value placed on this endeavor yet.

Discussion/Questions: WestVaco does not want PGC in its present location and they don't want the property. The multimillion \$\$ plans going around the club is why they need us gone so they can sell the land to someone else.

Berms? Before Berms can be moved, DHEC must ok the clean up.

Do we have a contract? If all key issues are resolved that are listed in the letter. Then that would be the time to draw up a contract with WestVaco.

What about the zoning window for Colleton County? Must be zoned as a gun range before the July deadline.

WestVaco is working on this.

What about the Wet Lands on the new range? Will need a permit to fill in part and convert pond into another wetland – or build a bridge across the creek. WestVaco may alter the property proposal to get around the Wetlands or get permit to fill. Could also move rifle range over and loose 1,000 yard line but still have 800 yard.

IMPORTANT: July PGC meeting is critical to attend. Should have answer to our letter from WestVaco.

Motion: Chester Cox (on behalf of John Lowe) To have night shoot in October at PGC. Tentatively scheduled for October 9th. Members have gone and talked to all the neighbors. None of them had an issue with a night shoot being held. (Membership would not vote on original motion --- too many unanswered questions.)

Suggestions from Membership:

- Decrease time to end before 11pm.
- Have to have an RO with you in the bay during the shoot
- There will be max amount of shooters stated

New Motion from Membership: Need a comprehensive plan put together and then bring it back to the club for a vote. Vote on new motion – 29 in favor / 3 Opposed / 1 abstained

Paul Taylor offered his expertise to John Lowe to assist with setting up specific's for safety for the night shoot. Email address and phone number forwarded to John.

# PGC TRAINING CLASSES AND CWP

Please put the following in the Bullseye newsletter. I got several requests for such a class. So, instead of doing the CWP class, we decided to do a pistol marksmanship class on the third weekend in August.

Aug. 21-22 Pistol Marksmanship, Sat. 09:00-17:00, Sun. 09:00-17:00

On August 2nd of 2010 a new system for acquiring a Concealed Weapons Permit will be implemented by the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division.

1. The applicant will go online [www.L1enrollment.com](http://www.L1enrollment.com) (That's the letter "L" and the number "1".) and enter their information. Or the applicant can apply by phone at (866) 254-2366.
2. The applicant must then go to an L-1 office to present their driver's license, training certificate, and be fingerprinted on a digital Livescan fingerprint reader. (This system is much better than rolling your prints with ink.)

In addition to the \$50.00 fee to SLED, there will be a \$10.00 fee to L-1 for the electronic fingerprinting and such. So, it will be a total of \$60.00 by credit card, electronic check, certified check, or money order.

The same process will be used for renewals. If you are giving a class with 25 students or more, L-1 will come to your class to do the fingerprinting and such.

SLED expects this system to greatly reduce the amount of time it takes to get your CWP card to you.

Jonathan Low, the PGC Chief Instructor, will continue giving the 2-day defensive pistol class on the third weekend of each month. Students may use this class to acquire their CWP. Reservations required,

Dear Mac:

This letter follows our May 24, 2010 meeting at MeadWestvaco (“MWV”) to discuss the property exchange. Gary Wilson, Bob Clark and I met with you to discuss the progress of the project. We identified the following key items that need to be addressed:

**Turnkey Transaction.**

The property exchange of the Palmetto Gun Club (“PGC”) property on Summer Road (the “Old Range”) for the new MWV property (the “New Range”) and move of PGC’s shooting facilities needs to be a “turnkey” transaction at no cost to the PGC. All of the costs of the project including, but not limited to, remediation, engineering, construction, site preparation and professional fees need to be covered by MWV.

**South Carolina Shooting Range Protection Act.**

The New Range needs to have established the cloak of protection from the South Carolina Shooting Range Protection Act (the “Act”). In

order to establish this protection, the transaction will need to be structured with PGC leasing the New Range from MWV for \$1.00 a year for six (6) years. Minimal improvements need to be made to the New Range so that the PGC can alternate shooting weekly matches at the New Range and Old Range every other month. The required postings need to be made at the New Range and documented with pictures and affidavits. After the requisite five years to establish the protection of the Act has passed and has been documented, the construction on the New Range can be completed, the Old Range remediated and the berms on the Old Range moved to the New Range. After there is a clean bill of health for environmental matters on the Old Range, the exchange will take place.

If during the five year period a suit is commenced to prevent PGC from operating at the New Range, MWV will fund fighting the suit. If PGC loses the suit and it is prevented from operating at the New Range, PGC will move all of its operations back to the Old Range. The New Range will be remediated for any lead issues and the berms from the New Range will be moved to the Old Range.

If another location cannot be identified to which the Old Range can be moved, PGC with MWV's assistance will reconfigure the Old Range to provide larger berms and enhanced physical safety measures to provide MWV additional comfort with PGC's shooting range being located in its current property.

## **Responsibility for the Old Range.**

MWV will be responsible for the Old Range after the exchange, including, but not limited to all environmental cleanup of the Old Range. During the five (5) year period for establishing the New Range under the Act, PGC, at MWV's expense will commence an environmental remediation program on the Old Range to minimize the environmental work necessary when it is time to complete the exchange.

As we discussed in the meeting, we recognize that MWV likely will never take title to the Old Range, but will have the Old Range deeded either to a 3rd party recipient such as the county or to a single purpose subsidiary entity. PGC must have the comfort that if an issue arises after the land is exchanged that MWV will be responsible for the issue and PGC will not be responsible for it.

## **Other Issues Discussed.**

We also discussed the following other issues.

***Wetlands and Waters of the US.*** In the course of PGC conducting its due diligence on the New Range, we have determined that a significant wetland exists from the western boundary to the eastern boundary of the New Range. We actually have determined that it is not just a wetland, but is a small creek that would be classified as “waters of the US.” It appears the wetland and the creek, together, create both state and federal permitting issues. In order to move the shooting range to the New Range property, sufficient permits will need to be obtained (1) to mitigate converting part of the wetlands to be used as a gun range and (2) to build a bridge across the creek. Alternatively, some other suitable solution needs to be determined. Perhaps the pond created by excavating to provide the materials to create the berms can be converted into a wetland to mitigate converting the portion of the wetland to use as the shooting range. We would assume MWV has a development team which includes a permitting team that could address the OCRM and Army Corps of Engineers issues to determine the feasibility of obtaining these permits. This solution may involve significant expense and time for MWV before the PGC can even start shooting on the New Range.

***Buffer.*** We also mentioned concern about the minimal buffer between the end of the New Range property and the 3<sup>rd</sup> party owner’s property down range of the proposed shooting range. As we explained, the

range development guidelines that govern construction of new ranges provide for safety requirements with either significant land expanses or engineered safety mechanisms. To build a shooting range using land as the safety mechanism would require PGC to have approximately 2,000 acres of land. The engineered solution which is being planned requires less land. Some buffers are prudent for noise and safety. You may recall that when we were looking at the other site on this MWV tract, at one point we were talking about a significantly longer tract of land with a large MWV tract of land down range as a buffer. At one point, the total acres being discussed were approximately 478 acres plus leased land down range.

***Shotgun Shooting.*** As we had previously discussed in connection with the other tract of land, Members continue to want to have a shotgun facility. This would require an additional amount of land north of the parking area and pistol range.

Two additional alternatives to addressing the wetlands and creek issues and the additional land issue are (1) shifting the shooting range north on the existing site or (2) relocating the shooting range on this or another MWV tract.

You had indicated that you would like to have your attorneys speak with PGC's attorney about whether zoning the New Range can eliminate the necessity of the lengthy process of establishing protection under the Act. Foster Gaillard is PGC's counsel and you can have your lawyers contact him directly.

Our goal is to try to resolve as many of the challenges to moving the range as we can at the earliest stage in the process in order to minimize expense. One of the goals of this letter is to start a running list of items that need to be addressed.
